The Path Line

"Every teen deserves the opportunity of a new path."

The Path Line launched just over a month as a direct line of hope for youth in foster care and extension of foster care (EFC) ages 13 and up. This is a direct line for teens and young adults to reach out for immediate support. Since it's launch, we have over 10 youth in our program needing a variety of support services including independent living, education and medical.

"I've been in foster care since I was 13 years old. I'm 20 now and in extension of foster care. Jonathan's Path has helped me more in 3 weeks than the last 7 years."




Progress survey of JP Youth shows feeling of hope for the future increased from 3 to 5!

A Note from JP's Executive Director

While speaking with a teen that just joined our program last week, he reminded me that the core of what these youth need goes beyond services. He reached out to Jonathan's Path via The Path Line and simply stated I need help with independent living. However, once we got to know him, the real need surfaced. He craved to be seen, to belong and have a purpose.

For teens in foster care/EFC, the instability and disruptions in their living situations and personal lives can often undermine their sense of self-worth and belonging. It is imperative to recognize the inherent dignity of every young person and afford them the respect and support necessary for their personal growth. So what makes our program so different or successful? It's what we do in between the services every single day., such as a text message of encouragement in the middle of the day, making a big deal out of accomplishing something most take for granted, offering the tough love talks followed by hug, picking them back up on the days they fall, and never giving up. Giving them dignity by leveling the playing field, purpose by listening and helping them discover what dreams are made of is what every foster child deserves.

Recognizing the potential in every youth, irrespective of their past circumstances, not only ensures their dignity but also contributes to breaking the cycle of adversity that may persist across generations. Join us on our mission to change the lives of teens in foster care one at a time.
