The Path Line

Since launching The Path Line in late September, an average of two teenagers a week submitted inquiries for support with an average of 2.2 services needed. As anticipated, the ability to access medical, dental and mental health services quickly is the most requested need, followed by clothing, food and independent living needs tied for second. The Path Line: Homelessness to Hope

The story of Vincent Ross, a young man aging out of foster care and facing homelessness, is a testament to the profound impact that a simple act of kindness can have on an individual's trajectory. Thanks to the incredible generosity of an anonymous couple, Vincent's life took an unexpected turn for the better.

Vincent, like many teens in foster care facing the daunting prospect of aging out of the system, had two options 1) join extension of foster care (EFC) or 2) go out on his own. Vincent joined EFC, but due to the lack of foster homes and no available beds for EFC youth, he was headed to the homeless shelter the next day. "My mental health was in at a critical level just knowing the next day I was homeless." said Vincent.

A social worker told Vincent about The Path Line. He is submitted an inquiry online and within an hour, Vincent was on a new path. Jonathan's Path found safe housing, worked with him daily from 8am to 8pm on all manner of independent living skills.

Vincent took charge of his life. Instead of facing the grim possibility of homelessness, he now holds two jobs, diligently working towards financial independence.

Anonymous donors decided to donate their older family car to Jonathan's Path for Vincent. The donated car not only facilitated his commute but also opened up opportunities for better employment prospects. "I'm going to continue to stay on this path and none of it would be possible without Jonathan's Path and the "earth angels" who donated the car," said Ross. Read more News & Events page on website.

Vincent's journey didn't stop at securing employment. Fueled by newfound determination, he enrolled in a GED program to complete his high school education. "I owe this to myself and to those that are making it possible for me to achieve it," said Ross. "Since day one at JP, my life changed for the better and I'm never looking back," said Vincent.

The story of Vincent Ross serves as a powerful reminder that acts of kindness, whether big or small and The Path Line has the potential to transform lives.

The Path Line

I contacted Path Line on behalf of a teenager in foster care who has received zero support/encouragement/literally anything. I have felt desperate for anyone besides my family to show her that she is worthy of care and support, and have felt completely drained from spending the last year fighting for even the most basic things for her. Not even an hour after I filled out the contact form, Jonathan's Path called and said "Yes, we can help her." She is a teenager who had a need and that was all Jonathan's Path needed to know to help. The Path Line: Empowered Beginnings

Brianna was one of the first to contact The Path Line about her goal to live independently, but not knowing where to start. Guided by the mentorship of Jonathan's Path, she learned the nuances of the apartment-hunting process, mastered budgeting, and gained insights into credit management. Armed with this knowledge, Brianna not only secured her first apartment but also set the stage for a financially secure future. "Every time I call someone answers and is ready to help. I've never had this level of support anytime I needed it," stated Brianna.

Jonathan's Path mentorship with one of our volunteers proved instrumental not only in Brianna's housing success but also in steering her toward her dream career in real estate.

Recognizing her passion and potential, a local Keller Williams office in Mt. Juliet offered to sponsor Brianna's real estate license path by providing access to online education, paying for her license test and propelling her into the world of realty. "I think I just screamed with excitement," laughed Brianna.




